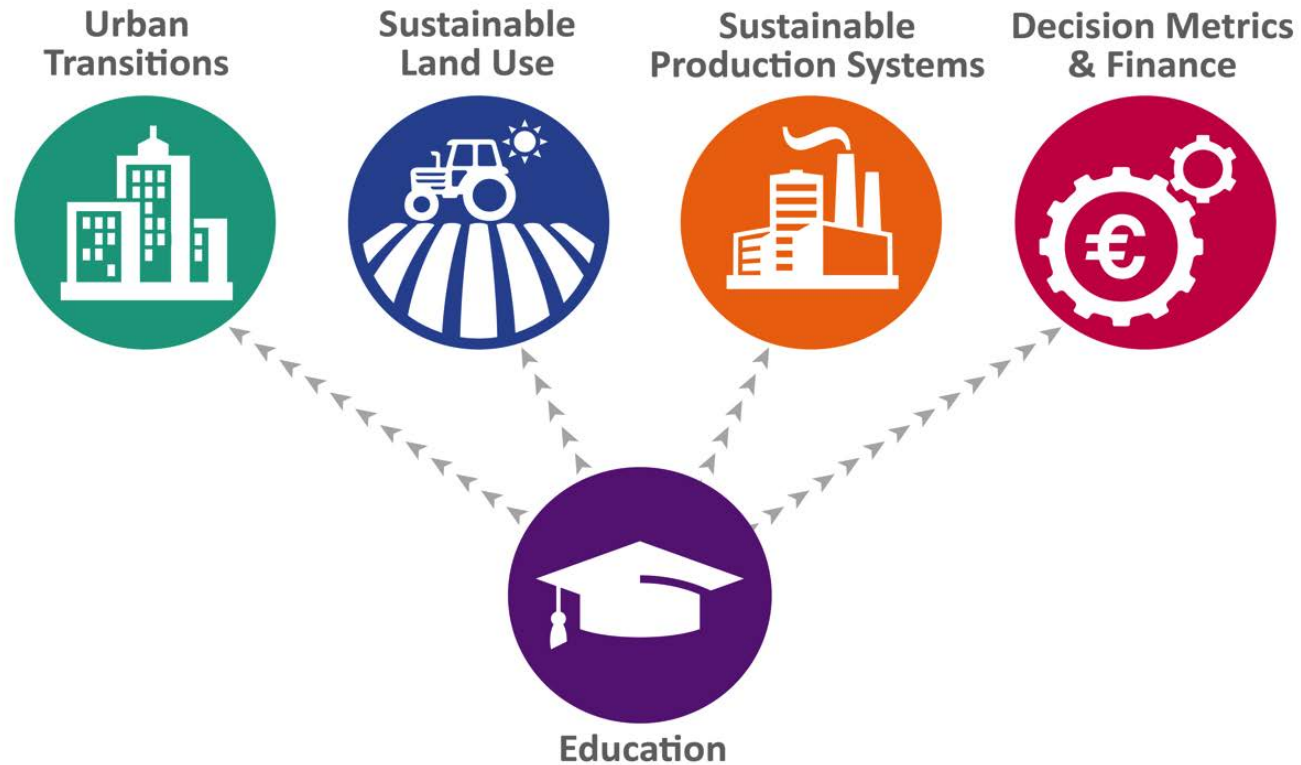

- Company must be incorporated before entering the programme
- Dedicated team
- Based in Denmark, Finland, Norway or Sweden
